TO THE AUTHORS:

The following outline provides the order in which each section should appear in your manuscript, as well as the necessary details for proper formatting. In revising your manuscript, **please make the following corrections in format** to save unnecessary publication delays after acceptance. **WARNING: If your final version is accepted, ASPET reserves the right to bill authors for excessive (over 15) changes (other than corrections of printer errors) made to the proof.**

I. TITLE PAGE (must be page 1)

- Follow the laboratory(ies) of origin by authors' initials & **remove indicators within list of authors**
 Treat "support" as an unnumbered footnote to title (no character); list information on the Footnotes page.
 Title page should be numbered.

II. RUNNING TITLE PAGE (must be page 2)

- Running title should be **60 characters only**, including spaces and punctuation.
 Provide corresponding author's name, address, and e-mail address.
 Please provide the document statistics on separate lines, (number of text pages, tables, figures, references, and the number of words in the Abstract, Introduction, and Discussion) specified at our website.
 List of non-standard abbreviations is missing. List should contain words/phrases of more than 20 characters.
 Please eliminate all abbreviations for words/phrases with 20 or fewer characters (except in equations).
 Eliminate Keywords from manuscript.

III. ABSTRACT (must be page 3)

IMPORTANT: If your manuscript is accepted, this abstract will appear on line EXACTLY the way you submit it. Please make sure to code all special characters, including sub/superscripts, and update the original submitted abstract.

- Too long - reduce to 250 words.
 Must be one paragraph

IV. BODY OF MANUSCRIPT

- Introduction is too long - reduce to 750 words.
 Discussion is too long - reduce to 1500 words.
 Move financial support credit from Acknowledgements to Footnotes section.

V. REFERENCES

- Please follow the proper MOL reference citation style specified in the "Instructions to Authors" which can be found at our website (<http://molpharm.aspetjournals.org>).
 Must be in alphabetical order. Indent each reference or skip a line between each if single-spaced.
 Limited to 40 references.
 Begin the References section on a new page.
 Before submitting, proof and crosscheck references to text citations.

VI. LEGENDS FOR FIGURES **Come BEFORE Tables.**

List in consecutive order instead of one per page.

VII. TABLES

- Each table must begin on a separate page appearing after the Legends for Figures.
 Pages with tables should be numbered.

VIII. FIGURES

Make sure ALL figures have a resolution setting of 600 DPI and are scaled to fit on an 8.5" X 11" sheet of paper

- All letters and symbols must be approximately the same size font and no smaller than 8 pt. or 2.5 mm.
 Label the front of every figure with the figure number only; do not include ...et al information.
 Each figure should be on a separate page.
 Figures pages should NOT be numbered.

Acceptable formats for revision submission include JPG, TIF, EPS, & PowerPoint.

IX. OTHER

- Number pages (w/o et al info), beginning with the Title Page through Legends for Figures and Tables.
 List each section as follows and in this order: Title Page, Running Title Page, Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgments, **References, Footnotes, Legends for Figures, Tables and Figures.**
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
